43	authority is specifically delegated.	

1 (b) The Division Secretary and the program director or manager shall also approve the 2 proposed pay rate before the initial employment is made to an applicant. 3 (c) The Division Secretary and the program director or manager shall not offer or approve employment if selection was made contrary to the Personnel Policies or the Cherokee 4 5 Code. (d) Transfers, promotions, demotions and terminations of employees shall be approved 6 7 by the Division Secretary and the Human Resources Secretary.
