RESOLUTION NO. 53 (2021)

- WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians ("EBCI" or "Tribe") has the sovereign authority to exclude persons from lands of the Eastern Band in order to protect the integrity, law and order of those lands and the welfare of the members of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has codified its authority to exclude persons from the lands of the Eastern Band at Chapter 2 of the Cherokee Code; and
- WHEREAS, the power to exclude is an inherent and essential part of Tribal sovereignty that is indispensable to the Tribe's autonomy and self-governance; and
- WHEREAS, EUGENE MURRAY OOCUMMA (date of birth 05/29/1990) is not a member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, and has been residing on Tribal trust land at 1562 Wolfetown Road; and
- WHEREAS, on June 4, 2021, EUGENE MURRAY OOCUMMA was arrested on Goose Creek Road on the Qualla Boundary and charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance Schedule II Fentanyl, in violation of Cherokee Code § 14-95.5(a); and
- WHEREAS, EUGENE MURRAY OOCUMMA was taken before a Cherokee Court
 Magistrate on September 1, 2021, and a Writ of Emergency Temporary Exclusion
 was issued and served on him by hand delivering a copy of the Writ to him, and
 he was scheduled to appear before Tribal Council on September 9, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, EUGENE MURRAY OOCUMMA has a prior criminal history including arrests for Misdemeanor Larceny in Haywood County, Second Degree Trespass in Haywood County, Felony Possession of Schedule II Controlled Substance in Jackson County, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia in Jackson County, Disorderly Conduct in Cherokee, and Drugs in Cherokee; and
- WHEREAS, EUGENE MURRAY OOCUMMA was placed on felony probation from Duchese County, Utah for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs, Open Container of Alcohol in a Vehicle, Making a False Report, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, an Ignition Interlock Violation and other various drug and alcohol related crimes; and
- WHEREAS, due to the nature of these charges and based on his residing on Tribal trust land, the Tribal Council has good reason to believe that EUGENE MURRAY OOCUMMA is a threat to the integrity, law and order of EBCI lands and the

welfare of the members of the Tribe.

- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council, in Annual Council assembled with a quorum present and with the number of votes required by Tribal law, EUGENE MURRAY OOCUMMA is hereby permanently excluded from all Tribal lands and is hereby notified and ordered to vacate all tribal lands.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this permanent exclusion prohibits EUGENE MURRAY OOCUMMA from entering on or being present on Tribal lands for any purpose except as required by Tribal Council or Tribal Court.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if EUGENE MURRAY OOCUMMA is found improperly on Tribal lands at any time after the effective date of this resolution he shall be treated as a trespasser and appropriate legal action shall be taken against him.
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
