Betty Drake to members of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians for 31 years, the Tribal Council does hereby adopt the Rev. Betty Drake as an honorary member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Executive Committee shall be and is hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED The adopted name of Rev. Betty Drake shal be 80 7005-200 servant to the people.
