On December 10, 1987, the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians passed Resolution No. 64 (1987), which had subsequently been properly ratified.

In this resolution the Tribal Council recognized the services rendered by Rev. Betty Drake to the members of the Eastern Band for over 31 years; and adopted her as an honorary member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians. The adopted name given to Rev. Drake is "Sarvant to the people".

WHEREAS, Rev. Drake has served as Pastor of the Cherokee Penecostal Holiness Church and Co-Pastor of the Big Cove Penecostal Holiness Church, and

WHEREAS, In addition to pastoring the said churches, she has driven countless times to Asheville to administer to the needs of the tribal members in both hospitals in Asheville. She also visits Haywood County, C. J. Harris, Swain County and Cherokee Indian Hospitals, and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of certain members of the Cherokee Penecostal Holiness Church that the Rev. Betty Drake be made an Honorary member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Annual Council assembled at which a quorum is present, that in appreciation for the spirited services rendered by Rev. Betty Drake to members of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians for 31 years, the Tribal Council does hereby adopt the Rev. Betty Drake as an honorary member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Executive Committee shall be and is hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED The adopted name of Rev. Betty Drake shall be BO TOS-20AV servant to the people.
