Resolution No. 292 (1979)

WHEREAS, Thomas Lane Mallonee has served as Administrative Assistant to Congressmen Roy J. Taylor and Larmar Grudger during their terms of office; and

WHEREAS, for more than nineteen years Thomas Lane Mallonee has served faithfully and well the Cherokee people in his capacity as Administrative Assistant; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Lane Mallonee has always shown great concern for the economic and legal matters affecting the Cherokee people and the Eastern Band and has always made his services and those of the office of the Congressmen for the 11th Congressional District in North Carolina immediately available to the Cherokee people; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Lane Mallonee has also been a close and valued friend to many of the Cherokee people, earning their trust and admiration for his personal qualities of forthrightness, honesty and integrity, as well as for his professional competence; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians desires to honor Thomas Lane Mallonee for his concern and work for the Cherokee people.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in Regular Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that an expression of appreciation and gratitude is hereby extended to Thomas Lane Mallonee for his years of service to the members of the Eastern Band.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Thomas Lane Mallonee be made an Honorary Member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, with the name of *DhO-bb* "The Messenger" in recognition of services rendered to the members of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.
