- NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in Regular Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that an expression of appreciation and gratitude is hereby extended to Thomas Lane Mallonee for his years of service to the members of the Eastern Band.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Thomas Lane Mallonee be made an Honorary Member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, with the name of DhObO ""The Messenger" in recognition of services rendered to the members of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians. 12
