- WHEREAS: A significant number of our Indian people are well acquainted with Dr. Tucker's tireless efforts on their behalf, and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Tucker's many patients, friends and fellow workers feel that some indication of the Cherokee people's deep respect and gratitude should be forthcoming on the occasion of Dr. Tucker's departure,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Annual Council assembled, at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Council does hereby bestow upon Dr. Virginia Tucker the distinction of "Honorary Member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians," such distinction representing the deep and abiding respect and gratitude which the Cherokee people feel for love and friendship demonstrated by Virginia during her stay with us.
