WHEREAS: many members of the Eastern Band have received invaluable information instructions and advice regarding farming, gardening, landscaping, soil conservation and home beautification from Fred Brown during the past 35 years, and

WHEREAS: Fred Brown has devoted many hours of his personal time in assisting Tribal members and Community Clubs of the Reservation in preparing exhibit for the Cherokee Indian Fair and the Cherokee Fall Festival.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by The Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Annual Council assembled at which a quorum is present, that Fred Brown is hereby declared an honorary member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.
