RESOLUTION NO. 153 (1974)

- WHEREAS, Theodore C. Krenzke has served as Superintendent of the Cherokee Indian Agency for over eight years, and
- WHEREAS, During this time the Krenzke family has been active in church, community and civic activities and has made many friends, and
- WHEREAS, Theodore C. Krenzke has maintained an unusually good and close relationship with the Eastern Band of Cherokee Tribal officials, Tribal Council, and the members of the Cherokee Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, He has served the Eastern Band and the entire area in a most dedicated and efficient manner,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Annual Council assembled at which a quorum is present that an expression of appreciation and gratitude are hereby extended to Theodore C. Krenzke for his unselfish service to the Cherokee Indian Agency and the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Theodore C. Krenzke shall be made an honorary member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians with the name of <u>STANDS TALL</u>" (DE GA DO GA) "HE WHO STANDS TALL" in recognition of services rendered the Tribe.
