7 8		ce amending C.C. Chapter 18B governing the Tribal Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission (TABCC) to amend requirements for budgeting and pricing.
9 10 11	WHEREAS,	the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians is a sovereign Indian tribal nation with the inherent right to make laws and govern its own affairs, and it has expressed its laws in the Cherokee Code; and
12 13 14 15 16	WHEREAS,	in 2009, with the creation of Cherokee Code (C.C.) Chapter 18B, the Tribe established a uniform system of control and regulation of the sale, purchase, transportation, manufacture, consumption, and possession of alcoholic beverages on the Tribe's trust lands, and established the Tribal Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission (TABCC) to carry out the law; and
17 18	WHEREAS,	the TABCC is tasked with enforcing the alcoholic beverage laws of the Tribe including the collection of revenue derived from permits, sales, and fees; and
19 20 21 22 23 24	WHEREAS,	the Tribe's experience with C.C. Chapter 18B and the TABCC since 2009 has revealed the need to amend the chapter to apply the same uniform budgeting process to the TABCC as is required of all other Tribal government divisions, and to tailor pricing of certain alcoholic beverages so establishments on Tribal trust land can be competitive with establishments in neighboring, state-regulated jurisdictions; and
25 26	WHEREAS,	the amendments expressed in this ordinance are presented to provide greater accountability for the revenue collected by TABCC on behalf of the Tribe.
27 28 29	NOW THERE	EFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, C.C. § 18B-204 and § 18B-804, are hereby amended to read as follows:
30	Sec. 18B-204	Allocation of revenues.
31 32 33 34 35 36	Fund. This of the Cor Tribal Cou	stablished within the Tribal ABC Commission a fund to be known as the ABC is fund shall be used to maintain sufficient funding for the annual operational costs in mission, to include personnel, contracts, and equipment costs as approved by the funcil through the annual budget process. The Tribal ABC Commission shall present the budget to Tribal Council for approval in the same manner and on the same as required of other divisions and programs of the Tribe.

1 2	(b) Any funds in excess of \$5,000,000.00 shall be returned to the Tribe on an annual basis not		
3	later than September 30 of each fiscal year. Money obtained by the Tribal ABC Commission		
4	through the exercise of its authorities provided in C.C. Chapter 18B, that are in excess of the		
	amount approved and budgeted by Tribal Council for the Tribal ABC Commission, shall be		
5	paid by the Commission to the Tribal treasury on a monthly basis, and deposited in the		
6	General Fund.		
7	(c) That the excess funds shall be dedicated to Tribal Council to be allocated as part of the		
8	Tribe's General Fund at the discretion of Tribal Council.

10	Sec. 18B-804 Alcoholic beverage pricing.		
11	The uniform pricing of spirits sold to permittees and the public shall be the same uniform		
12	price as published by North Carolina in GS Section 18B-804. Where a tax or markup is		
13	imposed by the North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission or a local board.		
14	both as defined in GS Section 18B-101, in this section, the TABCC is authorized to impose		
15	the same tax or markup as a Tribal tax or markup, where appropriate, so that prices set by		
16	the TABCC are competitive with the prices in counties that surround or touch Tribal trust		
17	land. and to utilize such tax or markup in operations of TABCC and profits after operation		
18	shall be distributed as determined by Tribal Council.

	BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED this ordinance shall become effective upon ratification by the		
20	Principal Chief and shall be implemented immediately by the TABCC. Any prior		
21	ordinance that is in conflict with this ordinance is rescinded to the extent		
22	necessary to resolve the conflict.
