9 10	An ordinance to amend C.C. Chapter 16 to allow the conduct of community bingo games.
11	WHEREAS, Tribal law requires Class II and Class III gaming conducted on Tribal trust lands to
12	be regulated and licensed by the Tribal Gaming Commission (TGC); and
13	
14	WHEREAS, Class I games are not regulated and licensed by the TGC and include "social games
15	solely for prizes of minimal value or traditional forms of Indian gaming engaged in
16	by individuals as a part of, or in connection with, tribal ceremonies or celebrations"
17	(C.C. § 16-1(f)); and
18	WHEREAS, bingo is, by default, treated under federal law and Tribal law as a Class II game and
19 20	organized bingo conducted by the Tribe through the Tribal Bingo Enterprise (TBE)
20 21	was regulated and licensed by the TGC when the TBE was conducting such games;

24	WHEREAS, EBCI community clubs, enrolled members, and Tribal officials have long
25	conducted community or charitable bingo games to promote community goodwill
26	or to raise funds to donate to a social organization or a Cherokee family in need;

29	WHEREAS, community bingo community bingo games are not currently addressed in Tribal
30	law; and

32	WHEREAS, Tribal law should be amended so that community bingo games may be lawfully
33 34	conducted for their traditional purposes.
3 <del>5</del>	NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Tribal
36	Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that C.C. § 16-1(g) shall be
37	amended to read as follows, and C.C. Chapter 16 shall be amended by adding
38	thereto a new section, identified as C.C. § 16-1.05B, to read as follows:

40	Sec. 16-1 Definitions.
41	Unless a different meaning is set forth below, the terms used in this chapter shall have
42	the same meaning as defined in the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, Public Law 100-
43	497, 102 Stat. 2467 (Oct. 17, 1988), 25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq. (IGRA).

(g) Class II Gaming means Class II Gaming as defined at 25 U.S.C. 2703(7)(A), and 1 2 any regulations promulgated thereunder but shall not include "community bingo" 3 as that term is defined in Cherokee Code Sec. 16-1.05B. - Community bingo. 4 5 Sec. 16-1.05B. - Community bingo. (a) Nothing in this Chapter shall apply to "community bingo" games as defined in this 6 7 section. 8 (b) "Community bingo" means bingo games periodically conducted by EBCI community clubs officially recognized by the Tribal government, EBCI government offices or 9 government officials, or EBCI enrolled members, to promote community cohesion and 10 goodwill or for charitable purposes such as to raise money to donate to community 11 12 members or community organizations in need, and for which the prizes have minimal value. When applied to community bingo games, "minimal value" means an individual 13 prize has a value no greater than two-hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), and no community 14 15 bingo game may offer a cash prize; provided, however, that gift cards for goods or services may be offered as prizes so long as such gift cards do not exceed a value of two-16 17 hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00). 18 19 20 21 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all ordinances that are inconsistent with this ordinance are 22 rescinded, and that this ordinance shall become effective when ratified by the 23 Principal Chief. 24
