Sec. 105-5 to allow a portion of Tribal Levy revenues to be 9 allocated to economic development. 10 11 WHEREAS, C.C. Sec. 105-5 governs the deposit, allocation and use of Tribal Levy funds collected by the Tribe; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Sec. 105-5 authorizes the use of Tribal Levy funds for multiple public services 14 such as law enforcement, fire protection, outdoor lighting in communities, 15 sanitation, and to provide financial assistance to the Cherokee Historical 16 17 Association and the Museum of the Cherokee Indians; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Sec. 105-5 should be amended to add economic development as one of the 20 authorized uses of Tribal Levy revenues, subject to needs-based budget 21 requirements. 22 23 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council, in Council assembled at which a quorum is present, that C.C. Sec. 105-5 24 shall be amended to read as follows: 25 26 27 Sec. 105-5. Use of Tribal Levy funds. 28 (a) All funds collected by the Eastern Band pursuant to this article shall be deposited promptly 29 into a special bank account in the name of the Eastern Band in a bank designated by the 30 Executive Committee, with the funds insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation. 31 (b) Tribal Levy revenues approved for the use of the Fire Department and Police Department, 32 as determined in a needs-based budget approach, shall be deposited in a fund or funds 33 designated for the use of those departments. These funds shall be disbursed in accordance 34 with an annual budget and approved by Tribal Council and shall be limited to the following 35 uses: (1) To pay necessary expenses of administering and enforcing this Ordinance, including 36 compensation for the Chief, Vice-Chief, and other Tribal employees responsible for 37 administering and enforcing the Tribal Levy Ordinance; 38 (2) To provide law enforcement and promote public safety on the lands of the Eastern 39 Band of the Cherokee Indian, including compensation for law enforcement officers; 40 (3) To provide and maintain fire protection services on the lands of the Eastern Band of 41 the Cherokee Indian: 42

(4) To provide street lighting for the Village of Cherokee and in other Reservation

communities as may be designated by the Community Services Committee;

- 1 (c) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be allocated to the General Fund as recommended by the Finance Committee and approved by the Tribal Council in the adoption of an annual budget.
- 4 (d) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be allocated to Sanitation providing for garbage collection and disposal systems, as well as providing sanitation facilities and services to foster and protect public health as recommended by the Community Services Committee and approved by the Tribal Council in the adoption of an annual budget.
- 9 (e) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be 10 allocated to the Tribal Marketing and Promotions Fund as approved by the Tribal Council in 11 the adoption of an annual budget.
- 12 (f) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be 13 allocated to the Tribal Education Program as recommended by the Tribal Education 14 Committee and approved by the Tribal Council in the adoption of an annual budget.
- 15 (g) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be
  16 allocated to the Tribal Reserve Fund to be utilized only by specific Tribal Council
  17 authorization and only in the event of an emergency presented by shortage in Tribal
  18 operating funds. The term "emergency" shall not be interpreted to mean shortfalls that could
  19 have or should have been reasonably foreseen.
- (h) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be
   allocated to a Greenway's Maintenance Fund for the purpose of maintaining the Tribal
   Greenways systems as approved by Tribal Council in the adoption of an annual budget.
- 23 (i) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be 24 allocated to the Cherokee Historical Association to provide the non-profit with operational 25 support in the perpetuation and preservation of Cherokee history and culture as approved by 26 Tribal Council in the adoption of an annual budget.
- 27 (j) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be 28 allocated to the Acquoni Expo Center, also known as the "old high school property," for the 29 purposes of maintaining the facility as approved by the Tribal Council in the adoption of an 30 annual budget.
- 31 (k) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be 32 allocation to the Museum of the Cherokee Indian to provide the non-profit with operational 33 support in the perpetuation and preservation of Cherokee history and culture as approved by 34 the Tribal Council in the adoption of an annual budget.
- (1) A portion of Tribal Levy revenues as determined in a needs-based budget approach shall be
   allocated to economic development.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that all ordinances that are inconsistent with this ordinance are rescinded, and that this ordinance shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
