RESOLUTION NO. 299 (2024)

*A resolution to exclude Timothy "Tim" Richardson and Mary "Penny" Richardson
from the lands of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians.*

- WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians ("EBCTI" or "Tribe") has the sovereign authority to exclude persons from lands of the Eastern Band to protect the integrity, law and order of the lands, and the welfare of Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has codified its authority to exclude persons from the lands of the Eastern Band at Chapter 2 of the Cherokee Code; and
- WHEREAS, the power to exclude is an inherent and essential part of Tribal sovereignty that is indispensable to the Tribe's autonomy and self-governance; and
- WHEREAS, Timothy and Mary Richardson are not members of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, but reside on the property of Noah Cucumber Heirs Parcel No. 305, located within the Wolftown Community, and
- WHEREAS, on April 29, 2024, Tim and Mary Richardson were terminated from their employment as campground managers of C & C Enterprises, Inc. D.B.A. Happy Holiday Campground by the Board of Directors.
- WHEREAS, on April 18, 2012, Tim and Mary Richardson signed a supplemental agreement for employees living onsite where they agreed vacate the premises within 48 hours of (voluntary or involuntary) termination of employment (Exhibit 1, sec. 3.), and
- WHEREAS, on May 24, 2024, after allowing the Richardsons 35 days longer than agreed upon to vacate the property, current campground manager Amy Riesco informed the Richardsons that their final date in the company provided housing expires May 29, 2024, providing an additional five days to vacate, at which time the Richardsons made it clear that they had no intention of leaving the property and claimed to have a life estate on the property, and
- WHEREAS, on March 26, 2019, the former President of C & C Enterprises, Inc., unilaterally and without Board approval or knowledge, signed an agreement with the Richardsons giving them indefinite use of the mobile home and utilities located on the property of the Noah Cucumber Heirs until they were no longer living in residence by their choice, and
- WHEREAS, since their termination, the Richardsons have been spreading rumors and causing issues with campground guests and the new managers that is disrupting business operations in the misplaced belief that they will be reinstated in their positions as campground managers, and

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2024, C & C Enterprises, Inc filed a complaint for eviction in Cherokee Tribal Small Claims Court, and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2024, while awaiting trial, the Board and the Richardsons reached a verbal agreement, to be later put in writing, that the Richardsons could stay in the residence until September 31, and in exchange the Richardsons would pay \$650 a month for rent and refrain from making disparaging comments to staff and customers,

WHEREAS, on the same day as the oral agreement was made between the parties, Tim Richardson immediately breached that agreement by going to customers and staff bragging that he won and that it is his campground, and

WHEREAS, after the breach of the oral agreement the Board decided to restart the eviction process, and ask the Tribal Council to banish the Richardsons from Tribal lands, and

WHEREAS, shareholders, employees, and customers have reported discriminatory comments against Native Americans and are sowing discord among campers and staff, and

WHEREAS, shareholders and the Board have voted and unanimously decided that the Richardsons must go and banishment is the best option due to the Richardsons' knowledge of eviction laws and their willingness to take advantage of the Board's generosity to stay rent and bill free at the expense of tribal members, of which many are Tribal elders who struggle to pay their own bills, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council, in Council assembled with a quorum present, and with the number of votes required by Tribal law, Timothy "Tim" Richardson and Mary "Penny" Richardson, is hereby INDEFINATELY EXCLUDED from all Tribal lands and is hereby notified and ordered to vacate all tribal lands.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this permanent exclusion prohibits Timothy "Tim" Richardson and Mary "Penny" Richardson from entering or being present on Tribal lands for any purpose except as required by Tribal Council or Tribal Court.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if Timothy "Tim" Richardson and Mary "Penny" Richardson is found improperly on Tribal lands at any time after the effective date of this resolution, he shall be treated as a trespasser and appropriate legal action shall be taken against him.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.

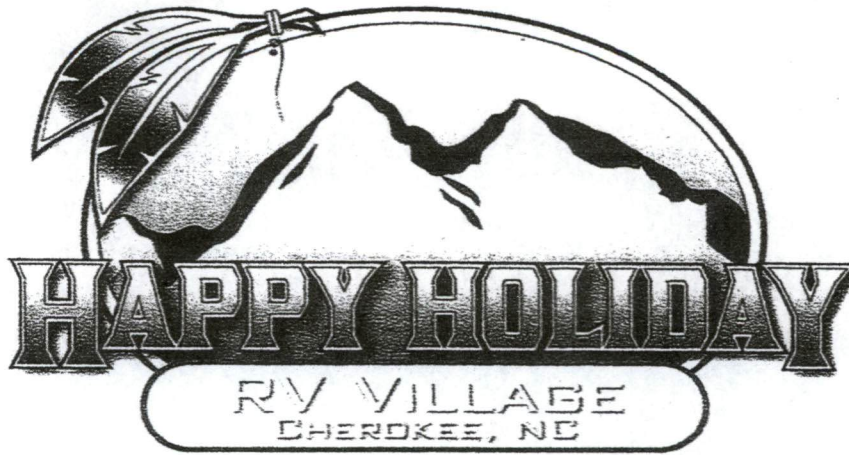

**SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT:
EMPLOYEES LIVING ONSITE**

You have been given use of a site at Happy Holiday RV Village as partial or full consideration for your employment. Please read the following regulations, as this represents an agreement between parties.

1. You are bound by park rules and regulations and must adhere to them. Failure to do so may result in the termination of your employment and your being required to leave the property on 48 hours written notice from Happy Holiday RV Village management.
2. Employee acknowledges that rules and regulations apply to all guests residing within the employee's unit, and is responsible for behavior of any guests visiting employee's site.
3. Upon (voluntary or involuntary) termination of employment with Happy Holiday RV Village, you will be required to leave the property within 48 hours written notice from Happy Holiday RV Village management.
4. Exceptions to the above may be granted if requested in writing, in conjunction with an application for your site. It will be the sole discretion of management to determine whether the request and application are accepted. If not accepted, you will be required to leave the property within 48 hours written notice as outlined above.
5. If Happy Holiday RV Village management's preference is for you to vacate the property and you do not, an eviction proceeding will be brought against you and you may be held liable for utility and rental costs associated, as well as legal fees incurred by Happy Holiday RV Village.
6. By signing below, employee acknowledges these rules and agrees to the conditions therein, and acknowledges further that signatures are affixed without coercion or duress.

In exchange for their many years of management, past and future years to come, and not taking a raise or year-end bonus, at any time we agree to the following terms.

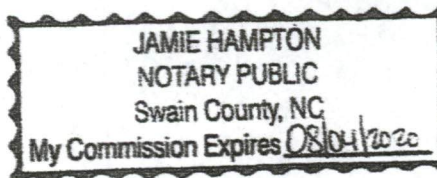

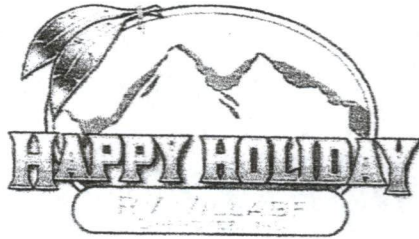

I contacted Ms. Mary (Penny) Richardson via telephone and had a conversation with her reminding her that her final date in the company provided housing expires on May 29th, 2024. I also informed her that the company attorney has begun the eviction process. She explained that she has an attorney, and they have a home being built off site with no current date on when the new residence will be complete. My understanding is that neither she nor Tim Richardson have any intention of leaving the residence anytime soon.

Managers will be salaried at \$1,000.00 per pay period each. This also includes their site, all utilities, laundry and propane at no cost. Any raises or bonuses or other compensations will be given at the discretion of Frank Cucumber President of C & C Enterprises.

For the above compensation the managers will run the campground 24 hours a day 7 days a week which includes maintaining the office, overseeing maintenance and general day to day operations.

Their position will begin on October 1, 2013 and continues for an unlimited amount of time and as long as Happy Holiday Campground and C & C Enterprises prospers under their management.



Statement of Negative Encounter with Tim

On October 29th, 2023, my mom, Lisa Youngdeer (shareholder) requested that I go pick up a letter for her from the office at Happy Holiday Campground. I called the campground to let the staff know that I would be there later to pick up the letter and was told that the office would be open until 5 pm. The employee who answered said that she would leave the letter on the desk at the office so it could be found by anyone who happened to be there when I got there.

I arrived at the campground around 4:40 pm and the office was dark inside and the door was locked. I tried calling a couple of times to see if I could reach someone and no answer. While I was standing outside the office, two older ladies (housekeepers) in a golf cart came up to me and informed me that the office was closed. I explained the situation and what I was told by the person I had spoke to on the phone earlier that day, and they said they would try to find someone that could help. They said they would go to see Tim and ask him if he could get the letter for me because they knew *he had a key*. One lady made the remark that they were happy to help me as much as they could, but they were afraid to make Tim mad and get in trouble.

The ladies returned to the office a few minutes later and said that Tim refused to come to the office and told them to tell me that the office was closed for the day. Given the situation, and the fact that the office was not supposed to be closed for another 15 minutes or so, I told them the importance of the letter I was there to pick up. They then agreed to show me where Tim was so I could talk to him myself. Before driving off, one of the ladies again mentioned that they hoped they wouldn't get in trouble for showing me where Tim was.

I went to the trailer and knocked on the door. For a few minutes, nobody came to the door even though you could clearly see Tim and Penny sitting in the living room through the screen door. Finally, Tim came out. I tried explaining what I was there for and before I could finish, he cut me off and said the office was closed for the day. I said that I was told they were open until 5 and it was still about 10 minutes before. He said "We're closed. No point in being open right now, so we sent everyone home". I tried to explain why I needed that letter and that the ladies in the golf cart said he had a key. Again, he refused to go over to the office with the excuse of "I don't want to mess with their stuff". I said "I was told by the person on the phone earlier that they were going to leave it right on the front desk where any of the staff could just go and grab it".

This went on for a few minutes with him making snide, backhanded comments about how grateful our family should be that they do all this "hard" work for our campground. I finally said "well what are we even paying you all for if you're not even going to stay open until you're supposed to and all you've got to do is walk over to the office, open the door, and grab the letter that is clearly marked with my mom's name?". Then he said "Don't even go there!". I said "Look, I need this letter, it's important that I get it for my mom. She would have gotten it herself but she can't get around well enough to get it herself". Eventually Tim agreed to open the door, but it wasn't himself that did it. He called Amy(?), who was all the way across the campground to drive over and unlock the door and get the letter for me.

Amy was nothing but pleasant about it and even apologized for the trouble that I had to go through to get it.
