1	(c) "Home cultivation" means the growing, tending, and harvesting of cannabis plants by a
2	registered patient or registered Designated Primary caregiver for personal medicinal use.

4	C.C. 17-90 Right to Cultivate.
5	(a) Medical Cannabis Patients and Designated Primary Caregivers must register their
6	growing space with the Cannabis Control Board and must provide proof of secure
7	growing conditions such as a locked room or an enclosed secure area away from public
8	view and locked from any persons under the age of 21.
9	(b) Registered medical cannabis patients may cultivate up to 12 cannabis plants, with a
10	maximum of 6 mature (flowering) plants at any given time.
11	(1) Registered Designated Primary Caregiver may grow the number of plants allowed
12	to the patient and shall not exceed 5 total patients
13	(2) Registered Medical Cannabis card holders may only have 1 Designated Primary
14	Caregiver at any given time.
15	(c) Cannabis cultivation may only occur on property lawfully in possession of the registered
16	patient or registered Designated primary caregiver or with the written consent of the person
17	in lawful possession of the property.

19	C.C. 17-91 Penalties for Non-compliance.
20	(a) Violations of this provision, such as cultivating more plants than allowed or failing to
21	register with the cannabis control board may result in fines up to \$500 or revocation of the
22	patient or caregiver card.
23 24	BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED, that all ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with this ordinance
2 4 25	are hereby rescinded, and this ordinance shall become effective upon ratification by
26	the Principal Chief.
