8 9 10 11	An ordinance to amend C.C. Sections 105.1, 105-31 and 105-33 to increase the Tribal levy rate and short-term rental privilege tax rate.
12 13 14	WHEREAS, Cherokee Code (C.C.) Section 105.1 imposes a Tribal levy on all retail sales of goods or merchandise on Tribal land, and the current levy rate is 7.5%; and
15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, C.C. Section 105-30 imposes a short-term rental privilege tax on operators of hotels, motels, tourist homes, tourist camps, campgrounds, rental cabins, and similar type businesses; and
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, currently C.C. § 105-31 imposes a four percent (4%) tax on the sales price for each room for every day or night it the room is rented, and C.C. § 105-33 requires the Tribe to allocate the collected funds to various Tribal programs; and
23 24 25 26 27	WHEREAS, the levy rate has not been adjusted since 2011 (Ordinance No. 785 (2011)) and the the short-term rental privilege tax rate has not been adjusted since 2018 (Ordinance No. 59 (2018)) and is substantially below the rate imposed by surrounding destination communities; and
28 29 30 31 32	WHEREAS, the levy rate and the short-term rental privilege tax rate should be increased, and the allocation expressed in C.C. Section 105-33 for the short-term rental privilege tax should be amended to give the Tribe more flexibility in how those revenues are used.
33 34 35 36	NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Tribal Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that C.C. Section 105.1, Section 105-31 and Section 105-33 shall be amended to read as follows:
37	Sec. 105-1 Tribal Levy imposed.
38 39	The Levy which may be imposed under this article is limited to a tax at the rate of seven and one-half <u>nine (9%)</u> percent of:
40 41	(a) All retail sales of goods or merchandise by persons or firms trading or conducting business on the Cherokee Indian Reservation; and

1	(b) All admission charges made by persons or firms presenting attractions on the Cherokee
2	Indian Reservation, except for admission charges by attractions which are presented by a
3	nonprofit organization.
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5	Sec. 105-31 Rate.
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7	(a) The Privilege Tax rate for hotels, motels, tourist homes, residences, bed and breakfasts,
8	<u>Airbnbs</u> , and cottages under Subsections 105-30(1) shall be four five and one-half
9	percent (5.5%) of sales price for each room for every day or night it is rented.
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11	(b) The Privilege Tax rate for tourist camps and campgrounds under Subsections 105-30(1)
12	shall be four five and one-half percent (5.5%) of sales price for each site for every day or
13	night it is rented.
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15	(c) The percentage rate of four five and one-half percent (5.5%) of the sales price shall apply
16	on sales starting at 12:01 a.m. in the morning of March 1, 2018 July 15, 2025.

18 19	Sec. 105-33 Use of funds.
20	(a) All funds collected by the Fostern Pand numericant to this activity in 1911 and the
21	(a) All funds collected by the Eastern Band pursuant to this article shall be deposited <u>into the</u> <u>Tribe's General Fund</u> . promptly into a special bank account in the name of the Eastern
22	Band in a bank designated by the Executive Committee, with the funds insured by the
23	Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

25	(b) Twenty-five percent of the one-half of the short-term privilege tax collected shall be
26	deposited in the Cherokee Tribal Sanitation Budget, specifically sanitation to eliminate
27	the solid waste user fee for households. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with
28	the annual budget adopted by the Tribal Council.
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30	(c) Fifty percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Travel & Promotion
31	Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the
32 33	Tribal Council for the purpose of Tourism and shall be used as follows:
33 34	(1) To promote the Tribele bettled
35	(1) To promote the Tribe's bottled water program; and
36	(2) To help fund events sponsored by the Tribe and held at the Cherokee fairgrounds and
37	other locations in Cherokee and for fairgrounds maintenance.

39	(d) Three percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Cultural
40	Preservation Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget
41	adopted by the Tribal Council for the purposes of cultural preservation.
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43	(e) Three percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Youth Sports
44	Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the
45	Tribal Council for the purposes of youth sports.

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2	(f) Three percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Health
3	Transportation Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget
4	adopted by the Tribal Council for the purposes of travel to medical services.
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6	(g) Three percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Fuel Assistance
7	Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the
8	Tribal Council for the purposes of providing fuel.
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10	(h) Thirteen percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Tribal Recreation
11	Program Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget
12	adopted by the Tribal Council for the purpose of providing Tribal recreation programs.
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15	\BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are
16	rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective on October 1, 2025,
17	contingent upon ratification by the Principal Chief.
