BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Principal Chief is hereby authorized to submit the necessary fee to trust application and supporting documents to the U.S. Secretary of the Interior to have the property described in in this resolution placed into trust with the United States for the benefit of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, and the Principal Chief is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents including deed(s) to transfer the property described herein to the United States in trust for the benefit of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians. BE IT FINALLY Resolved that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
