19		Cherokee School Board, its members, responsibilities, and election; and

45		described above, Cherokee Code Chapter 115 is hereby amended as follows:

4	If a vacancy occurs within the School Board due to death, resignation or removal, the Tribal

7	days remains in the original term on the date of vacancy, the seat shall remain vacant until the next

11	BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED, that all ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with this ordinance		
12	are rescinded, and this ordinance shall become effective upon ratification by the		
13	Principal Chief.
