26 27	(a) A person is guilty of taking indecent liberties with children if, being 18 years of age

30		liberties with any minor for the purpose of arousing or gratifying sexual
31		desire; or
32		b. Willfully commits or attempts to commit any lewd or lascivious act upon
33		or with the body or any part or member of the body of a minor.

6	are rescinded for crimes committed subsequent to ratification of this ordinance. This
7	ordinance shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief.
