Sec. 14-40.40. - Homicide in the first degree.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to:
 - (1) Purposely, knowingly, and wrongfully and with premeditation and deliberation, cause the death of another human being; or
 - (2) Cause the death of another human being due to the commission or attempted commission of a felony or offense punishable by exclusion.
- (b) Homicide in the first degree shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$15,000.00, by a term of imprisonment not to exceed less than three years nor more than three years, none of which may be suspended; exclusion for a period not less than ten years nor more than life; or any combination of them.

Sec. 14-40.41. - Homicide in the second degree.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to:
 - (1) Recklessly or negligently with disregard of the possible consequence of one's conduct to cause the death of another human being; or
 - (2) Cause the death of another human being by operating a motor vehicle in a reckless, negligent, or careless manner, or while under the influence of an alcoholic beverage, intoxicating liquor, a controlled substance, or any drug, to a degree which renders the person incapable of safely driving a vehicle.
 - a. A blood alcohol content in excess of .08 shall create a rebuttable presumption that the person was under the influence of an alcoholic beverage.
 - b. For purposes of this section, a motor vehicle is any self-propelled vehicle and includes, but is not limited to, any automobile, truck, van, motorcycle, train, engine, watercraft, aircraft, or snowmobile.
- (b) Homicide in the second degree shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$15,000.00, by a term of imprisonment not less than 2 years and not to exceed three years, none of which may be suspended; exclusion for a period of not less than one year nor more than life; or any combination of them.
- BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED, that all ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with this ordinance are rescinded for crimes committed subsequent to ratification of this ordinance. This ordinance shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief.
