23		responsibilities, and work separately, the ordinances governing the TGC and the
24		TCGE Board would be improved by making the terms of the members on each
25		governing body consistent between them, to express the requirement for
26		confirmation of appointees by Tribal Council, and to state that appointees may
27		serve until their replacement is appointed.

29	NO.	W THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Tribal
30	~	Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that C.C. Section 16-2.01 and
31	•	C.C. Section 16A-3 shall be amended to read as follows:

33	Sec.	16-2.01. Establishment.
34	(a)	Composition of the Commission: The Tribal Gaming Commission shall be composed of
35	` ,	three enrolled members of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians who must have clearly
36		demonstrated their business acumen through past business or career successes.
37	(h)	Appointment of Commissioners: Commissioners shall be appointed by the Principal Chief,
38	(0)	subject to the approval of the Tribal Council. Nominees to the Commission shall be selected
39		on the basis of their business experience and ability to significantly contribute to the
40		capabilities and functions of the Commission. A Commission appointment shall not create a
41		property interest.

42	(c)	Commissioners may hold other positions of employment and may engage in business;
43		provided, however, that they shall not engage in any business regulated pursuant to the
44		provisions of this chapter.

- 1 (d) Except as provided in subsection (e), each Commissioner shall serve a term of three five
 2 years, subject to removal, with cause, by a majority of the Tribal Council. There shall be a
 3 six-month probationary period for each new appointee to be reviewed by the Principal Chief
 4 and the Tribal Council. A member of the Commission may continue to serve on the
 5 Commission after the expiration of their five year term until their replacement is appointed
 6 and confirmed.
- 7 (e) To ensure continuity in the Commission and rotation of appointments, the existing
 8 Commissioners shall continue to serve, but their terms shall be adjusted so that they serve
 9 staggered terms. The three year terms shall continue as follows: Seat A's term shall expire
 10 12/31/2018; Seat B's term shall expire 12/31/2019; and Seat C's term shall expire
 11 12/31/2020 for future new, renewal or replacement appointments shall specify which seat is
 12 being considered.
- 13 (1) Term limits: No individual shall serve on the Commission more than two terms.
- 14 (f) No Commissioner shall be finally approved until he or she has completed a background investigation pursuant to section 16-2.03.
- 16 (g) Before assuming office, each Commissioner shall take the oath of office administered to Tribal officers.
- 18 (h) Resignation: A Commissioner may resign at any time by providing the Principal Chief and
 19 Tribal Council with written notice of his or her intention to resign on a date certain. The
 20 resignation shall become effective on the date stated and need not be accepted by the
 21 Principal Chief or Tribal Council to be effective.
- Vacancies: A nomination to fill a vacancy in the Commission shall be made by the Principal Chief within 30 days after the date on which the vacancy becomes effective. The Principal Chief shall then submit the nominee's resume to the Tribal Council for their approval.

 Action by the Tribal Council shall occur within 30 days after receipt of the nomination from the Principal Chief.
- 27 (j) The Commission shall select annually, from its membership, a Commission Chair.

- 30 (a) Composition of the Board: The Board of Advisors shall be composed of five enrolled 31 members of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians who must have clearly demonstrated 32 their business acumen through past business or career successes.
- 33 (b) Appointment of the Board: Members of the Board of Advisors shall be appointed by the
 34 Principal Chief, subject to the approval of confirmation by the Tribal Council. Nominees to
 35 the Board of Advisors shall be selected on the basis of their business experience and ability
 36 to significantly contribute to the capabilities and functions of the gaming enterprise. At least
 37 one member of the Board of Advisors shall be an experienced auditor or certified public
 38 accountant, or shall have a Bachelor's Degree and significant financial and management
 39 experience in prior employment.
- 40 (c) Members of the Board of Advisors shall not engage in any business regulated pursuant to 41 the provisions of this chapter or chapter 16 of this Code, and shall refrain from outside

- employment which creates a conflict or the appearance of a conflict with their duties as members of the Board of Advisors.
- (d) Except as provided in subsection (e), each member of the Board of Advisors shall serve a
 term of five years, subject to removal, with cause, by a majority of the Tribal Council.
 There shall be a six-month probationary period for each new appointee to be reviewed by
 the Tribal Council. A member of the Board of Advisors may continue to serve on the Board
 after the expiration of their five year term until their replacement is appointed and
 confirmed.
- 9 (e) To ensure continuity in the Board and rotation of appointments, the initial Board members'
 10 terms shall be adjusted so that they serve staggered terms. Upon the effective date of this
 11 amendment, the Principal Chief shall assign first term expiration dates for each current
 12 Board member, such that one member's term expires each year beginning September 30,
 13 2000. The established rotation shall continue for each Board position for future new,
 14 renewal, or replacement appointments.
- 15 (1) Term limits: No individual shall serve on the Board more than twice.
- 16 (f) No member of the Board of Advisors shall be finally approved until he or she has 17 successfully completed a primary management official background investigation conducted 18 by the Tribal Gaming Commission as provided in chapter 16 of this Code.
- 19 (g) Members of the Board of Advisors must complete a multijurisdictional background check 20 conducted by the regulatory authorities of each jurisdiction where an operation exists, is 21 licensed, or as identified by this Board or Tribal Council, and be licensed prior to the 22 conclusion of their six-month probationary period. Failure to obtain and maintain any 23 licensure in any jurisdiction or for any venture assigned to the Board of Advisors shall 24 require removal from the Board.
- 25 (h) Before assuming office, each member of the Board of Advisors shall take the oath of office administered to Tribal officers.
- 27 (i) Resignation from the Board of Advisors: A member of the Board of Advisors may resign at
 28 any time by providing the Principal Chief and Tribal Council with written notice of his or
 29 her intention to resign on a date certain. The resignation shall become effective on the date
 30 stated and need not be accepted by Principal Chief or the Tribal Council to be effective.
- Filling of vacancies in the Board of Advisors: A nomination to fill a vacancy in the Board of Advisors shall be made by the Principal Chief within 30 days after the date on which the vacancy becomes effective. The Principal Chief shall then submit the nominee's resume to the Tribal Council for their approval. Action by the Tribal Council shall occur within 30 days after receipt of the nomination from the Principal Chief. When a term of a member on the Board of Advisors expires, a Board member shall continue to serve until a replacement is named or the member is otherwise expressly removed from the Board.
- 38 BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that all ordinances that are inconsistent with this ordinance are rescinded, and that this ordinance shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
