RESOLUTION NO. 813 (2011)

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians has the sovereign authority to exclude persons from lands of the Eastern Band in order to protect the integrity, law and order of those lands and the welfare of the members of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has codified its authority to exclude persons from the lands of the Eastern Band at Chapter 2 of the Cherokee Code; and

WHEREAS, Angelica Michele Isom is not a member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians and is currently entering or residing on Tribal lands; and

WHEREAS, a Temporary Exclusion Resolution was passed, amended, and ratified on July 14, 2011, by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians; and

WHEREAS, Angelica Michele Isom has not been served with the aforementioned resolution; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council has good reason to believe that Angelica Michele Isom is a threat to the integrity, law and order on Tribal lands and territory or the welfare of its members by engaging in certain conduct such as possession of drug paraphernalia and receiving or possession of stolen property; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council, in Council assembled, with a quorum present, and with the number of votes required by Tribal law that Angelica Michele Isom remains temporarily excluded from all Tribal lands and IS HEREBY NOTIFIED AND ORDERED TO VACATE ALL TRIBAL LANDS and to remove all personal property from Tribal lands within 48 hours from the date this resolution is ratified. Any personal property remaining on Tribal lands after that period shall become the property of the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if Angelica Michele Isom is found on Cherokee lands at any time after being excluded, she shall be treated as a trespasser and law enforcement personnel shall arrest her and take other appropriate legal action against her.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this exclusion prohibits Angelica Michele Isom from entering or being present on Tribal lands for any purpose EXCEPT AS REQUIRED BY A SUBPOENA issued by the Cherokee Tribal Court or Cherokee Tribal Council by an officer of the Tribe with authority to issue subpoenas.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief.


